Day 1: Board your flight to Paris

Day 2: Paris

- Arrive at Charles de Gaulle International Airport and meet your tour leader.
- Enjoy living like a Parisian with a 5-day **metro pass** for zones 1-3.
- Stroll along the **River Seine** as an introduction to Parisian life.
- Visit the **Eiffel Tower**, the most famous landmark in Paris, with the option to look down over the Parisian landscape from the third level.

Day 3: Paris

- Take a 3-hour guided tour of the **City of Lights** where you will see marvelous monuments including: the oldest standing bridge of the **River Seine**, the **Pont-Neuf**, the **Ile de la Cité**, and the medieval cathedral **Notre Dame**.
- Make your way to the reverse pyramid at the **Carrousel du** Louvre on your free time.
- Enjoy a guided tour through the Musée du Louvre where you will see the iconic Mona Lisa by Leonardo da Vinci and other accomplished artists of the Renaissance and Reformation periods.
- Travel to **Charles de Gaulle-Étoile** to see the **Champs Élysées**, and the couture houses of Chanel, Cartier, Yves St Laurent and Pierre Cardin.

Day 4: Paris

- Start the day with a guided tour of the Musée d'Orsay to see mainly French art from 1848-1915 from famed artists Claude Monet, Édouard Manet, Edgar Degas, Pierre-Auguste Renoir, Paul Cézanne and Vincent Van Gogh.
- Explore the Latin Quarter with your tour leader.
- Visit **Sainte-Chapelle** and view the beautiful stained glass windows of this gothic church.
- Discover one of the world's largest military art and history museums in the world at the Army Museum. This selfguided tour will take you through collections of old weapons and armour, artillery models and a unique set of 19-century items related to Napoleon I.
- Stroll through the largest square in the capital at the **Place de la Concorde**. Dedicated to the reconciliation after the French Revolution, the square is now known for its fountains and obelisk which was donated by the King of Egypt.

Day 5: Versailles - Paris

- Start the day with an RER train journey to Versailles.
- Travel to the **Palace of Versailles**, a luxurious 17th century palace with grand gardens. Your audio guide will take you through the stunning **Grand Apartment**, the **Hall of Mirrors**, and the **King and Queen's suites**.
- Get lost in the stunning gardens of Versailles, which are landscaped in the French style, and date back to the reign of Louis XIV.
- Return to Paris.
- Make sure you have good walking shoes, next stop is the hilly Montmartre. Stoll through this charming neighbourhood to see the Sacre Coeur Basilica from the top of the hill, the Wall of Love and the Moulin Rouge.

Day 6: Paris

- Stroll through the **Pére Lachaise Cemetery** with your Tour Leader to see the tombstones of the famous people who have been buried here throughout the years.
- Still need a souvenir for your family? Head to the **Passage des Panoramas**, a busy shopping center and covered walkway that was built in 1799.
- Admire Haussmann's Paris as your Tour Leader guides you through the Opera District. This renovation added air and open space to the boulevards and connected and unified the different parts of the city.
- It's time for shopping! Explore the Grands Boulevards, especially Boulevard Haussmann and its famous department stores.
- All aboard! Savour the last bit of Paris as you listen to a commentary while cruising down the Seine River on a bateau-mouche.
