Christchurch Metro Overview - November 2018

In **Christchurch**, the average house price has increased from \$555,139 in November 2017 to \$570,235 in November 2018, which is an uplift of 2.72%.

Listings are back 4.21% on November 2017 from 570 to 546, but we are hopeful to see this change coming into the drier time of year.

New auctions are up 7.86% from 191 to 206 when we measure November 2017 against November 2018. This method of sale continues to lead the way in New Zealand's garden city where we have a good number of top auctioneers working to ensure the best outcomes for vendors.

Harcourts NZ CEO Chris Kennedy says, "figures for spring into summer have been as changeable as the weather. We expect to see some positivity filter through during the warmer months and we hope this will give both buyers and vendors confidence in the market.
