About Revenue River

Revenue River is a digital marketing agency that works across sales and human resources departments to build and execute strategic marketing plans. THE CHALLENGE

Revenue River was an early adopter of cloud computing, leveraging a dedicated server in a regional cloud provider's data center with remote IT support. They were all-in on the solution, but the antiquated technology was causing poor response time and performance.

Revenue River was looking to expand both coast to coast and globally, so they needed to migrate to an environment that would scale with them. The regional cloud provider was unable to provide that flexibility and lacked newer technology and services to scale and support their desired growth. The team at Revenue River also needed a full support system, as no one within the company could perform the migration alone, nor manage the environment post-migration.

THE SOLUTION

Revenue River's biggest concern was downtime and loss of data during the migration process. Prior to the migration, Privo evaluated Revenue River's current environment and came up with a design for their ideal cloud environment. They spun it up in parallel, where they were able to develop and test new features as data was migrated over. After many successful tests, the cutover occurred with the flip of a switch, and Privo staved onsite at Revenue River to make sure everyone's machines were configured correctly. Additionally, the Privo team implemented virtual desktops with Amazon Workspaces and recreated an active directory, file services, and a shared controlled environment to optimize employee efficiency. From design to deployment the migration process and implementation took one month.

THE BENEFITS

Pay-as-you-go - The biggest benefit Revenue River has experienced is moving to a utility model and having the ability to upgrade to the newest hardware and software, without the worry of breaking their system. This shift to the front of technology has provided improved system performance, response time, and time-to-resolution.

Seamless Migration - Revenue River had concerns going into the migration about potential downtime or loss of client data and collateral. However, Privo was able to perform the migration without any disruptions to the business or business data being compromised. Improved Efficiency - With the new ability to trust and lean on their IT system, Revenue River has been able to support a company growth of 61% and will continue to grow their business in the coming years. Despite this growth, Revenue River's IT costs have remained the same due to the lack of hardware needed.
