HYDRATING



Olive oil soap cleanses the skin without stripping the natural oils from it.

DRYING



Commercial soaps have an excess amount of alkali which makes it hard to maintain the skin's natural level of pH.

HYPOALLERGENIC

Olive oil soap is gentle enough to use on a newborn baby.

Recommended for people with sensitive skin and can soothe psoriasis, eczema and rosacea.



FULL OF CHEMICALS LIKE...

Parabens: gives the body extra estrogen, disrupts the endocrine system

Phthalates: can cause infertility and problems in sperm development

Petrochemicals: made from petroleum and should not be considered safe, as we do not know the long term effects

SLS/SLES: a drying skin irritant that corrodes the skin's surface found in soaps, lotions and engine degreasers

VEGAN

Olive Oil is used 'as the fat' in the saponification process meaning no animals were harmed in the making.



Olive Oil soap contains only natural ingredients making it 100% biodegradable and not harmful to the environment.



BIODEGRADABLE

ARTIFICIALLY SCENTED & COLORED

Besides the irritants mentioned above, commercial soaps contain both **synthetic perfumes** that are linked to allergies and hormonal imbalances and **artificial coloring** which has been known to cause health problems and illnesses in humans.



RICH IN ANTIOXIDANTS

Olive oil soap contains healthful antioxidants that provide nourishment and elasticity to the skin.



LACKING IN NUTRIENTS

Since most ingredients are synthetic, there are no natural added benefits of using a commercial bar of soap. Only added harm.
