Assisted Living Facilities and Nursing Homes have been a highlight of the news over the last four days. Our family, Jacaranda Trace and Sarasota Bay Club, has 123 Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing beds combined. As you may have seen, Governor DeSantis released the names of the Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing Facilities in Florida that have positive cases of COVID-19.

We are not one of the communities listed with a positive case and in our efforts to continue a proactive approach, we are in communication with business counterparts on a weekly basis. The communities we communicate with have been following the Guidelines of the CDC and Florida State Department of Health. All of us are fighting COVID-19 together.

As we have shared with you throughout this pandemic, we will communicate to you any positive or presumptively positive case we may have at any of our communities. **We continue to have none.**

We are prepared at our Skilled Nursing Facility in Sarasota to treat any case we may have at either community. Our Assisted Living does not have the physical plant or skilled staff required to treat positive cases of COVID-19, thus the need for care in Sarasota.

We have a dedicated COVID-19 team of licensed nurses at The Inn, located on the campus of Sarasota Bay Club. These nurses will only care for these positive cases and are receiving constant education. Any positive JT or SBC residents needing care would be admitted to this unit. Please know that we will not be admitting any positive cases from the hospital or any other local facility.

All other operational guidelines and restrictions remain in place. Thank you all for your continued support and all your efforts to keep us healthy and safe. Please continue to stay cautious as we all maintain our daily behaviors to stay healthy.
