RE: COVID-19 /Coronavirus Update #22

This memo will be a general update as related to COVID-19 management in both our communities, Sarasota Bay Club and Jacaranda Trace. We would like to start by expressing our sincere appreciation for your cooperation and support since the virus began. Without your help and cooperation, we would not be in the excellent condition we are in today. Our challenges are not over, in fact quite the opposite. We as a community must remain vigilant and not let our guard down. The virus will pass but this will go on for some time into the future.

As of this time we do not have any Club residents, staff, or family members of staff, having tested positive or presumptively positive for COVID-19.

If at any time you are not feeling well or think you may have a temperature, please don't hesitate to call us.

The President has presented a Federal Phased Opening Plan and our Governors are lifting restrictions in their states in varying degrees. The state of Florida began a "planned opening of the economy" just yesterday. The opening does not include Assisted Living or Skilled Nursing Facilities which remain in full lock down with no visitors allowed except for "end-of-life" compassion exceptions. We are choosing to "stay the course" in our independent living and remain steadfast in our own path and implemented protocols until we can gauge how the lifting of restrictions impacts our communities. It is imperative that we follow all the guidelines we have implemented. To that end, please remember:

- Family over the age of 18 may visit from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. They will not be permitted in any common areas to include entrance lobbies. They must be screened upon entry and have their temperature taken. They will be issued a wrist band and will then proceed directly to your home.
- Face masks are **mandatory** for everyone when you leave your unit and enter the elevators and common areas. Wearing a mask while walking outside and on the grounds is at your discretion.
- We ask that you continue to do your part and stay close to your condo and if you feel the need to go off campus, please ask yourself, is this necessary? If you must go out



remember, diligently following social distancing has been one of the keys to our success thus far.

- Medical personnel are allowed in if they pass screening and have a mask.
- We remind you that there is a protocol in place in the event of a positive case of COVID-19, and we are prepared to respond when and if necessary. Any resident or team member who may become stricken with COVID-19 will be embraced and treated with the utmost care and dignity. We outlined the process related to a positive case in update #21 which is on our website.
- Family visiting from out of state will be asked to self-isolate for 14 days so please keep this in mind when discussing plans with your family. Also, it is important you know we currently have the same travel restrictions in place for our staff.

We emphasize these policies are dynamic and are meant to keep us all safe. We evaluate their efficacy and usefulness on a daily basis. Our community will do whatever it takes to protect each other. We wish you all good health and good spirits as we face these challenging times together.
