RE: COVID-19 /Coronavirus Update #26

As we have promised to remain transparent throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, we are informing you we have had an employee whose visiting family member has tested positive for COVID-19. The visiting family member arrived from out-of-state this weekend and within hours of arrival was tested for COVID-19. Immediately after testing, the visiting family member was isolated from our employee. The family member's test came back positive yesterday.

The employee worked three shifts in memory care and was in both buildings A and B of Cadbury Park. Because potential exposure was limited only to the residents of Cadbury Park, they have been placed in isolation in their rooms. Temperatures and oxygen levels are being monitored each shift. Both buildings have been thoroughly cleaned with antibacterial/antiviral disinfectant.

While the employee remains asymptomatic, our nurse practitioner, Cindy Drew, along with one of our Concierge Physicians was instrumental in coordinating a Rapid Response Test with a lab utilized by Sarasota Memorial Hospital for the employee. The lab visited the employee's home this morning to conduct the test and we expect to have the results within 24-hours. Should the asymptomatic employee's test come back positive, we will immediately test all staff and residents in Cadbury Park.

Gail met with our in-house physician, Dr. Sohail Shariff, to discuss the potential exposure and the proposed plan of action, should the employee test positive. Dr. Shariff has endorsed this plan and encourages residents to reach out to him should they have any questions.

We are working to remind all staff members of proper protocols along with a tightening of our procedures already in place. We want to assure you the health and safety of all residents and staff remain our top priority. We will continue to keep you informed as we learn of the employee's test results.
