On Thursday, June 4th, we advised you that an employee at Jacaranda Trace had an exposure to COVID-19 through a visiting family member. On Thursday, a Rapid Response Team administered a COVID-19 test to the employee. As soon as we received the results, we notified you by an Alert Media Phone Blast that the employee tested negative. This memo is written confirmation of those results.

As of this time we return to our status of not having any Club residents, staff, or family members of staff, having tested positive or presumptively positive for COVID-19. This is a great tribute to all of you and to the team.

We will continue all resident assessment protocols we put in place on June 4th in the Memory Care Buildings for at least another 10 days.

PLEASE CONTINUE TO FOLLOW THE CURRENT PROTOCOLS IN PLACE AND KEEP UP THE GOOD WORK IN AVOIDING AND REPORTING ANY EXPOSURE TO COVID-19. YOUR CONTINUED COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROTOCOLS WILL HELP US KEEP EVERYONE SAFE.
