SSAT Score Report Primer— Middle & Upper Level

Scaled Score: The Score Scales in each section of the test are 440-710 on the Middle Level Test and 500-800 on the Upper Level Test. Scaled scores are reported after score equating. Scaled scores account for minor differences in form difficulty. They can be compared directly to scaled scores on other SSAT test forms; for example, a scaled score of 650 on a January 2020 test form reflects the same performance as a scaled score of 650 from a January 2019 form. **The scaled score is the most relevant data point for tracking student performance from year to year and from student to student. Because of the consistency provided in scaled scores, it is recommended that they be used when comparing students.**
