SSAT Score Report Primer - Elementary Level

Scaled Score:

The Score Scales in each section of the test are 300-600. Scaled scores are reported after score equating. Scaled scores account for minor differences in form difficulty. They can be compared directly to scaled scores on other SSAT Elementary forms. For example, a scaled score of 530 from the December 2019 test form reflects the same performance as a scaled score of 530 from a December 2018 form. **The scaled score is the most relevant data point for tracking student performance from year to year and from student to student. Because of the consistency provided in scaled scores, it is recommended that they be used when comparing students.**
