1. IAM and IGA Cybersecurity Advisory Assessments

This IAM microservices driven platform reduces the complexity, leverages existing investments, reduces implementation costs, and promotes agility of integrations into traditional cybersecurity infrastructure. The security practice teams at Good Dog Labs uses Perseus IAM as an integral part of integrating SailPoint and IBM IGI into enterprise integrations. This allows the team to do more robust customizations and detailed data normalization and dynamic mapping directly into an existing customers infrastructure. This forms part of a “Pre IGA” Project effort to continuously ensure identity and access data quality, accuracy, and health.
