#### PARENT COVENANT

The board, faculty, and staff of Dominion Christian School promise to assist parents in training their children by operating the school in accordance with its Statement of Faith, mission, philosophy of education, and stated policies.

In return, in keeping with the Biblical principle that parents are primarily responsible for the education of their children and recognizing that the school and parents must walk together in agreement in order for success to be the result (Amos 3:3), the School's board and administration asks parents or guardians of Dominion Christian School students to make the following acknowledgments and promises concerning their children.

- We understand and acknowledge our commitment to the stated Biblical Christian world view mission and philosophy of education at Dominion Christian School.
- ❖ We understand and promise to abide by the policies of Dominion Christian School as promulgated in appropriate school literature.
- We will keep apprised of our children's academic progress and behavior by appropriately communicating on a frequent and consistent basis with their teachers.

We want improper attitudes in our children properly confronted. When informed by the staff of behavioral infractions, we will properly discipline our child with the goal of ensuring that the infraction does not occur again. We wish to remain the children's primary disciplinary force and thus will fulfill our role in providing an atmosphere of discipline at home.
- \* If we profess Christ as our Savior, we promise to regularly pray for the school board, faculty, staff, and students of Dominion Christian School.
- We promise to provide our children with an adequate and regular time and place to study and complete homework.
- ❖ We promise to resolve disputes by dealing directly with the person or persons involved without criticizing them or the school. When the issue at hand is a sin issue the approach will be in accordance with the Biblical instruction found in Matthew 18:15. We will maintain confidentiality of matters between teachers and administration, not sharing these with our children or any other individual not a part of the problem or solution. #### A CHRISTIAN CLASSICAL EDUCATION

#### PHILOSOPHY OF DOMINION CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

At Dominion Christian School, we believe all things were created by God and the facts of reality can only be fully understood in terms of God's creative and redemptive purpose. (God is the author of all truth, not just "religious" truth.) All His creation is continually sustained by Him, reflecting His power, goodness, and order. Thus, "the fear of the Lord is the *beginning* of knowledge." God has delegated to mankind the continuing task of taking dominion over the earth, sea and air under the authority of God's law. We believe Scripture to be the only inerrant, authoritative Word of God. It is from Scripture that we derive and confirm all truth. Students truly learn, then, only in an environment acknowledging and submitting to, rather than suppressing, the authority of God and His Word in every area of life.

The Scriptures command us to love God "with all, your heart, soul, and *mind.*" Thus the school seeks to teach students how to think like Christians; that is to "demolish strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God" by "bringing every thought captive to the obedience of Christ" in every discipline and area of life (2 Cor. 10:5). Our primary goal is to provide students with both the Biblical worldview (the conceptual framework which is the definitive interpretation of reality), and the intellectual tools necessary to integrate the data of reality into, and rationally defend, the truth against those that "suppress the truth in unrighteousness" and "the oppositions of knowledge falsely-so-called" (Rom. 1:18; 1 Tim 6:20). Only such an education will enable the student to make ultimate sense of the world in which he lives and equip him to obey Christ's command to love Him with all his mind and to fulfill his cultural mandate to exercise dominion over the earth, bringing all things into subjection to Christ.

Scripture teaches in Deuteronomy 6:4-9 and Ephesians 6:1-4 that parents, not the State, are responsible for the education of their children. Although the teachers will act "in loco parentis" (in place of the parent), it is the responsibility of parents to educate their children in the Lord. The school is the delegate of the parent, assisting them in the education of their children, but it may not usurp the parents' God-given parental duty and responsibility. Parents are welcome and required to participate in their child's education at the school.

#### A CLASSICAL METHODOLOGY

At Dominion Christian School, we seek to immerse students in true, good, and beautiful things in the hope of inspiring a lifelong love of learning. We also seek to restore and employ the time-proven method of the *Trivium* in the education of the student. The Trivium includes three stages. The Grammar Stage is the study of fundamentals of various disciplines to build a body of core knowledge which subsequently can be ordered and arranged in the development of the student's reasoning and expression capabilities, and Christian worldview. Latin, the paradigm discipline of the Grammar Stage, begins in third grade. Questions of who, what, when, and where are the focus. The Dialectic (or Logic) stage brings the data of the Grammar Stage into ordered relationship. Formal and informal logic are taught during this phase. The goal is to equip students with thinking skills, making them capable of detecting sound and fallacious arguments. Questions of how and why are thoroughly addressed. The Rhetoric Stage makes use of the data of the Grammar Stage and the reasoning skills acquired in the Dialectic Stage to teach students how to express what they think eloquently and persuasively.
