## Hang Flyers

Hanging flyers might seem out of date but it can be an effective tactic. Most schools have flyer boards lining the hallways. Put up a flyer with your phone number, who knows someone might see it out of the corner of their eye on the way to class.



## Be Prepared

One of the most important keys to recruiting students is having a game plan. If a student approaches you, what is the next step? Make sure to get their name, phone number, and e-mail so you are able to contact them with more information. Try to schedule a meeting each semester for everyone that is interested.
