SNP Solution Enables Accurate Data Cleansing for Successful Carve-out

About AL-KO Kober

With its divisions „Gardentech“, „Ventilation and Air Conditioning Technology“ and „Automotive“, the AL-KO KOBER GROUP is one of the global players among German medium-sized companies. In 1931, Alois Kober laid the foundation for the company's rapid rise by setting up a small metalworking business in Kötzing, near Augsburg. Today, the long-standing family-owned company with around 2,400 employees is operating at more than 30 locations worldwide. In 2018, the AL-KO KOBER GROUP generated revenues of around 500 million euros. The Challenge

At the beginning of 2018, AL-KO KOBER SE took over business units and plants of an automotive supplier.

As part of the takeover, a new ERP system had to be set up and all data no longer required for AL-KO had to be selectively deleted. This involved cleaning up the vendor's ERP and HCM systems by deleting all company codes, with the exception of those for the acquired plants. One of the challenges was a large number of customer-specific tables that could not be completely cleaned up using SAP standard functionality and for which a specific logic had to be implemented.

The Solution

The solution was a combination of the SAP standard method SAP LT Clone & Delete and the SNP Transformation Backbone approach: In a Clone & Delete scenario, copies of the vendor's original systems were created. All company codes that were not required were then selectively deleted, including the dependent organizational units of the corresponding master data, transaction data and Customizing data. In a second step, the relevant archive files for the transferred company codes were selectively migrated from the vendor's archive system into a new archive system to be set up.

Due to the complexity and changed requirements in the course of the project, four test migrations were performed instead of the usual two before the go-live.

- Flexibility of the SNP approach
