OCC (OLD CORRUGATED CARDBOARD)

YES

- Clean, Flattened, Corrugated Cardboard

NO

- NO Grease or Food Contamination
- NO Frozen Food or Take Out Boxes
- NO Coffee Cups
- NO Coated Cardboard

COMMINGLED

YES

- Plastics #1, #2
- Clean Water and Soda Bottles
- Milk Jugs
- Aluminum Cans
- Clean Tin Food Cans
- Colored and Clear Glass Bottles

NO

- NO Plastic Grocery Bags
- NO Eating Utensils
- NO Styrofoam
- NO Plastic Wrap
- NO Broken Light-bulbs
- NO Electronics
- NO Scrap Metal
- NO Paint Cans

MIXED PAPER

YES

- Paperboard (*Tissue Boxes, Cereal Boxes*)
- Copy Paper
- Construction Paper
- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Envelopes (*including windows*)

NO

- NO Waxed Cartons (*containers that held liquid such as orange juice*)
- NO Used Paper Plates
- NO Used Napkins
- NO Paper Cups
- NO Receipts
- **NO FOOD RESIDUE WHATSOEVER!**

COMPOST

YES

- Fruits and Vegetables
- Eggshells
- Coffee Grounds and Filters
- Tea Bags
- Nut Shells
- Cardboard
- Paper
- Yard Trimmings
- Grass Clippings
- Leaves
- Biodegradable Plates and Silverware

NO

- NO Plates or Utensils labeled "biodegradable"
- NO Produce Stickers
- NO Plastic Wrap
- NO Tin Foil
