



Today's special
Creepy &
chocolate eyeballs

Ingredients (per child)

5 vanilla wafer cookies

1 bar white baking chocolate

2 dark M&M's or Smarties

Blue or green paste food coloring

Red liquid food coloring

Materials (per child)

1 small microwave proof bowl

Greaseproof paper

Scissors

Clear plastic bag

1 toothpick

1 plate

1. Place the greaseproof paper on the plate.

2. In a small microwave proof bowl, heat up $\frac{4}{5}$ blocks of white chocolate in the microwave until they've melted.

3. Put the melted white chocolate into a clear plastic bag. Snip off a corner of the bag and squeeze the bag from the top down to push the chocolate down and draw a spiral over the cookie from outside to the center. Leave it to spread out over the cookie by itself. Repeat with the remaining cookies. Refrigerate until the white chocolate is set.

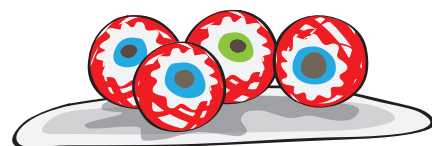
4. Melt the remaining $\frac{1}{5}$ of white chocolate. Colour it using the blue or green food colouring and shape it into two iris and place them on the cookies.

5. On each iris place a dark M&M or Smartie in the center for the pupil.

6. Refrigerate until set.

7. Use a toothpick dipped in red food coloring to draw lines creating bloodshot eyes. Chill until set.

8. Eat and enjoy!
