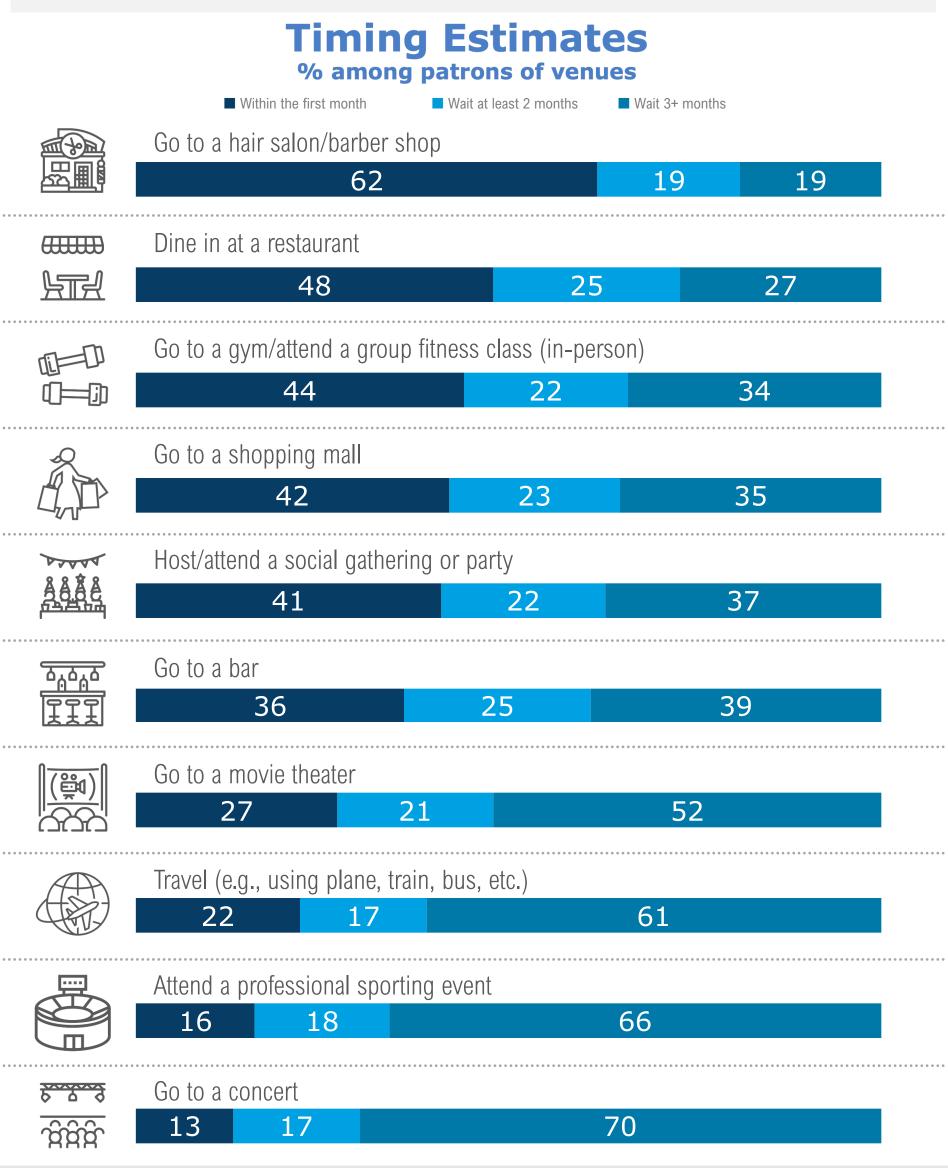

This week's insights were collected Friday, May 1 - Sunday, May 3 among a general population of n=400 U.S. consumers age 21+.

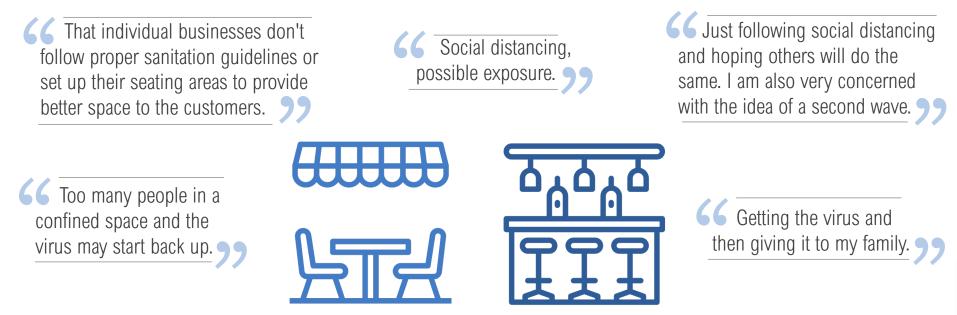
CONSUMERS WILL GO TO BUSINESSES IN PHASES

Hair salons and barber shops will be among the first to see their customer base return, whereas consumers are going to wait longer before returning to crowded activities, where social distancing is nearly impossible to uphold (i.e., going to concerts and sporting events or traveling on a plane, train, bus, etc.).



Concerns for Going Back to Bars & Restaurants

The biggest concerns for visiting bars and restaurants are the proximity to others (or the inability to appropriately social distance) and the additional spread or potential second wave of COVID-19.
