

Not only did we see continued gains in the number of events, tracks and guests, but this year also saw the addition of new people and partners, propelling both the quality and quantity of TCSW programming.

The new faces included a core programming team sourced from the startup ecosystem. Together with Nels, Meg, Danielle, Lauren, Dakota and Conner developed strategies and materials, empowering various Track Leads to host higher quality events. The team also introduced a volunteer army that gave over 350 hours of service. Branding, event design and video production were also enhanced, making the week more polished than it's ever been.
