

Demographic Breakdown



Fly-In Program 2018 Recap

The Fly-In Program started as a radical hypothesis that if we asked quality candidates to join us for TCSW to see just a glimpse of what the region has to offer, they would relocate here to live, work and play. This, at a time where we have countless open jobs, and one of the lowest unemployment rates in the country. In a joint effort with Make it MSP and Brand Messenger,

the TCSW team flew in nearly 40 people from around the world to explore our cities. Though still in the process, many candidates have already begun relocating for jobs; and for those still deciding, we've noted a positive increase in the perception that MN is a vibrant community that many should call home.
