SEVEN CADETS RECEIVE CONGRESSIONAL NOMINATIONS FROM ONE SCHOOL - UMA

SALT LAKE CITY, Utah, March 21, 2018 – With only 25-30 nominations given, per state, the Utah Military Academy (UMA) holds seven of those prestigious nominations from the Utah State Congressional Delegation to U.S. Military Service Academies. Members of Congress may nominate applicants who meet the eligibility requirements established by law.

Every year, dedicated cadets make a serious commitment to serving their country through applying to attend one of the United States Service Academies, including the United States Military Academy at West Point, the United States Naval Academy, the United States Merchant Marine Academy and the United States Air Force Academy.

Cadet Colonel Delia Cheney – US Air Force Academy

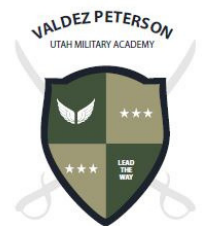
Cadet Chief Master Sergeant Hyrum Hone – US Merchant Marine Academy
