

# Introduction

**Rapid List Ordering** is an extension built to help webstores serve enterprises and B2B customers more efficiently, by providing them with a simple, list-based view that allows them to add multiple items to their cart in moments.

This extension is built to run on Magento 2, and supports both the Open Source and Commerce editions of the software.

In this guide, we will go over the major features of the Rapid List Ordering extension, and provide you with step-by-step installation instructions which will allow you to configure and use this extension properly, and modify it to fit your Magento installation. Let's begin now.

# Features

The Rapid List Ordering plugin has a number of helpful features.

- Simple, near-native UI designed to blend in with existing Magento functionality
- Intuitive add-to-cart text fields for fast and easy checkout
- Complete support of different product sizes, colors, and styles
- Integrates with Magento category and search filters
- Customizable functionality allows for manual or automatic addition of selected items to cart
- Design elements can be modified and customized to match all Magento themes and styling
- Simple configuration and installation
- Number of items loaded per page can be modified
- Regular patching and updates to ensure bug-free operation

# Installation Instructions

First, you'll need to install the Rapid List Ordering extension. Here is a step-by-step guide.

- 1. Back up your web directory and store database, to ensure your store can be restored in case of an error or installation failure.
- 2. Download the "Rapid List Ordering" installation package from the Magento web store.



- 3. Upload the contents of the "Rapid List Ordering" installation package to the root directory of your store.
- 4. Open up the SSH console of your server, and navigate to your store root folder and enter the following commands:

cd [path\_to\_the\_store\_root\_folder] (the path will vary based on your installation)

run: php -f bin/magento module:enable Ecommerce121\_Core

php -f bin/magento module:enable Ecommerce121\_RapidListOrdering

php -f bin/magento setup:upgrade

php -f bin/magento setup:di:compile

php -f bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy

5. The installation of the Rapid List Ordering extension is complete.

# Configuration

After you have installed the Rapid List Ordering extension, you can customize the extension to fit the style of your store, and modify its functionality to fit your particular requirements. We'll discuss the configuration of the extension now.

After installing Rapid List Ordering, you can modify the installation and configuration by navigating to the **Stores > Configuration** setting on the Magento sidebar, as shown below.

Make sure to select **Rapid List Ordering** in order to continue. Next, we will discuss every part of this screen in detail, to help you understand your options for customizing and modifying the functionality of Rapid List Ordering.



### Before We Begin – A Note On Cache Management

While configuring and modifying the Rapid List Ordering extension, it will be necessary to flush the cache of your Magento site cache after each change. You will see the following message when you change a setting on the Rapid List Ordering extension:

When you see this, simply click the **Cache Management** hyperlink to go to the Magento cache management screen. Then, press the orange **Flush Magento Cache** button, as seen below.

After you have done this, your Magento cash will be flushed, and the new configuration settings will be updated on the Rapid List Ordering extension.



#### General

The **General** option is self-explanatory. In this view, you will be able to **Enable** and **Disable** the Rapid List Ordering extension, by selecting either **Yes** or **No** on the drop-down menu.

Selecting Yes will activate the extension. Selection No will deactivate the extension.

#### Design

The next element of the Rapid List Ordering extension is **Design**. This section allows you to customize the design, text, color, and other elements of the extension, to ensure it fits your Magento installation.

# Text:

This section allows you to modify the **text color** and **hover color** of the Rapid List Ordering Extension, as well as the text that is **Displayed** when the extension is activated. The default color for both values is **#054b72**.

Again, by default, the colors will be set to #054b72. And, as shown in the **# Text** section, you can input your own hex values, or use a built-in color picker to modify the color of the button.

By modifying the color and text of the Rapid List Ordering button using these settings, you can quickly and easily integrate it into the overall theme of your Magento store.

# Settings

This is where the bulk of the functionality of the Rapid List Ordering extension can be controlled, such as the Automatic Add To Cart feature, and other functional elements like the number of items to load on each page. Let's discuss each part of Settings configuration in detail now.

## Automatic add to cart

This feature makes it easier for buyers to purchase multiple items at once, without having to confirm each individual addition to their cart.

When this setting is enabled, any number entered into the text field of the Rapid List Ordering menu will be recorded and added to the cart as soon as the user leaves the text field.

Here's an example. Automatic Add To Cart is enabled. When we go to the Magento store, we open the Rapid List Ordering menu, and then simply enter a quantity – say, 22 – into the text field next to the item we want to buy.

Then, as soon as we click elsewhere on the window, or use the TAB button to change text fields, these items are added to the cart, with no further clicks required.

To disable this functionality, simple change the **Yes** to **No** on the drop-down menu.

When you disable Automatic Add To Cart, each individual item will have a quantity selector added, as well as an **ADD TO CART** button, as seen below.

These items will not be added to the shopper's cart until they click the **ADD TO CART** button. You can toggle between Automatic Add To Cart and manual mode simply by changing the setting, whenever you like.



### # Clear Section Button

This section of the configuration menu allows you to control the behavior of the Clear Section button, which is an optional feature you can use with Rapid List Ordering.

When **Enable** is set to **Yes**, the button appears at the bottom of the Rapid List Ordering menu view, and allows users to clear all of their selections, as seen in this screenshot.

If **Enable** is set to **No**, there will be no **CLEAR SELECTIONS** button on the Rapid List Ordering interface.

As with the main Rapid List Ordering button, the color and style of the Clear Selections button can be changed. You can change the color of the:

- Text
- Border
- Background
- Text hover
- Border hover
- Background hover

This ensures you can match Rapid List Ordering to your Magento theme, and integrate it into your User Interface quickly and easily.

This button allows a user to add all items that have a quantity input to their cart at once. This is a handy feature that makes it easier for users to shop for bulk items.

**Enable** allows you to choose whether or not to use this feature. When set to **Yes**, this will activate the Add Selected Items To Cart button. When it's set to **No**, this functionality will be deactivated.

Rather than adding each item individually with the **ADD TO CART** button on the right, shoppers can simply press **ADD SELECTED ITEMS TO CART**. Then, all of these items will be added directly to their shopping cart.

Just like every other button in the Rapid List Ordering extension, you can modify the color and style of this button. The following colors can be changed:

- Text
- Border



- Background
- Text hover
- Border hover
- Background hover

#### A note about the Add Selected Items To Cart and Clear Selections features

If you wish to use the Add Selected Items to Cart and Clear Sections buttons with Rapid List Ordering, **you must disable the Automatic Add To Cart feature**.

The Automatic Add To Cart feature is not compatible with the Add Selected Item to Cart or Clear Section buttons. If Automatic Add To Cart is **Enabled**, these buttons will be **disabled automatically**.

This is because, due to the design of the Automatic Add To Cart feature, these other features are redundant.

When using the Automatic Add To Cart feature, all items are added to the shopping cart immediately after a quantity is entered and confirmed. This means there is no need for the user to clear their selections, or add all of their items to their cart at once.

#### # Grid

This feature allows you to set how many products will appear in the Rapid List Ordering view by default. It's set to 10, but you can choose how many products you will display.

This allows you to display the proper amount of products per page, based on your page loading times, Magento resources, and more.
