<p>Surgical Information Systems</p> <p>2014 edition criteria applicable: a3, a4, a5, a11, a12, a13, a17, d1, d5, d6, g1, g4</p>	<p>The Surgical Information Systems application provides functionality for surgical scheduling and surgical documentation, along with reporting tools. The application is intended to be used by nursing staff, anesthesia providers, and ancillary surgery staff, such as schedulers.</p> <p>Clinical documentation capabilities allow users to document, review, and edit patient demographics, vital signs, body mass index, a patient problem list, smoking status, family health history, and advanced directives. Users can also attach and review images in a patient’s record.</p> <p>Description of capabilities applies to the certified capabilities only. Additional information on non-certified capabilities can be found at www.SISFirst.com</p>	<p>Client pays a license fee on a one-time basis or an annual subscription basis. The software license fees are based on the number of Operating Rooms and Procedure Rooms in use by the hospital. If hospital’s use of the software changes (e.g., after acquiring a new facility, opening additional Operating Rooms or Procedure Rooms, or using the software in other areas of the hospital) the hospital may need to purchase additional room licenses.</p> <p>Client pays for initial implementation and installation of maintenance releases.</p> <p>Client pays for maintenance and support on an annual basis. If the client has chosen to pay by subscription, the maintenance and support fees are included in the annual payments.</p> <p>Support for integration of this certified product-version with other ONC certified systems may require additional one-time costs, such as reporting utility software fees, interface fees, professional services fees, and/or ongoing annual software maintenance and support fees.</p>	<p>No contractual limitations.</p>	<p>Transmission of data to public health agencies often involves mapping data in to standard terminologies (e.g. SNOMED), which may have their own licenses.</p> <p>Support for integration of the Surgical Information Systems application with other ONC certified systems may require additional software and services, such as a reporting interface or data extraction interface, along with the professional services, maintenance, and support fees associated with the additional software. Implementation may require coordination with the support staff for the other application.</p>
