GENERAL OVERVIEW



ISF was founded in 1995 by the city of Frankfurt, the State of Hesse, and multi-national corporations. It offers a world-class education from Kindergarten up to Grade 12. The state-of-the-art campus includes a theatre, indoor, semi-Olympic sized swimming pool, tennis courts, and an artificial sports field and running track.

PART OF A WORLDWIDE EDUCATION SYSTEM AND PHILOSOPHY

ISF is a member of SABIS®, a global school network that dates back to 1886 and currently educates over 70,000 students. All students in the SABIS® Network benefit from a long tradition of excellence in education, a reputation that is rooted in a well-developed philosophy that seeks to make a university education accessible to all students, not just a select few.

ACADEMIC COORDINATORS

ISF has a team of Academic Coordinators for Kindergarten, Primary School, Middle School, and High School. They liaise with parents, teachers, and students and ensure that new students are integrating well and that all students are on track. Parent Teacher Conferences are held twice a year.

COUNSELLING AND GUIDANCE

ISF students take weekly advising classes from grades 4 to 9 to discuss contemporary themes. In addition, we have a School Counsellor, a full-time nurse, and several highly qualified University Counsellors.



SABIS STUDENT LIFE ORGANIZATION® (SLO®)

Students are encouraged to get involved in the rich student engagement program run by the SABIS Student Life Organization®. SLO® helps students explore their talents, discover their interests, and develop essential life skills such as leadership, collaboration, cooperation, and critical thinking.



E-BOOKS

Students in grades 4 through 10 are required to have an android tablet which is used in class in conjunction with the SABIS® textbooks.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Students from grades 1 to 9 are required to wear the ISF polo shirt to school and the P.E. shirt for sports.

SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from ISF is possible via a number of means. For those opting for public transport, the S-Bahn stops (Sindlingen and Zeilsheim) bring students within a short walk of the campus.

A 'door-to-door' service is offered by private taxi companies and provides an alternative to public transportation.

SCHOOL MEALS

The school caterer offers a hot meal service at lunch time for all students. There is also a kiosk that offers snacks during breaks. Alternatively, students can opt to bring a packed lunch from home.

ISF PARENT NETWORK

The ISF Parent Network provides a supportive, welcoming environment for ISF families who are new to the area. It sponsors social events for parents and students, communicates regularly with the ISF Director, and contributes actively to the international atmosphere of the school.

ISF SPORTVEREIN (SPORTS CLUB)

The ISF Sports Club offers a wide range of sports and has teams that play in local leagues as well as the German International School Sports Tournaments (GISST) league. Sports on offer include: badminton, basketball, football, golf, gymnastics, swimming, tennis, track and field, and volleyball.
