TEAM LEAD - JOB DESCRIPTION

As a Team Lead (Solar Tech III), you will oversee the installation teams daily operation at the job site and will be responsible for the construction at each installation from start to finish. In this role, you will report directly to the Construction Supervisor.

RESPONSIBILITY

- Provide leadership for those reporting to you by clearly communicating goals, timeline and all pertinent information regarding current projects.
- Lead the installation of electrical systems that interconnect our solar array to our clients power grid.
- Prepare documentation relating to the installation of the solar array.
- Ensure all work performed by the Installation Team is of good workmanship and compliant with current NEC and local codes.
- Maintain compliance to all PPE and safety regulations per OSHA and Cool Earth Solar standards.
- Ensure the truck is equipped with inventory needed and ensure the vehicle is in a proper condition.
- Occasional work in the warehouse organizing equipment.
- Perform other needed job tasks as requested by leadership.
