ACTIVE GAMES



Musical Friends

Play a game like "Musical Chairs," but make it more friendship-oriented. Have children dance around the circle while the music is playing. When the music stops, they have to find a friend to link arms with and stand together until the music starts playing again.

Sticking to Our Friends

Write down the names of all the children in the class on small pieces of fax paper. Blow up some balloons. Have the children rub the balloons on their clothing and create static electricity. Talk about how we all have to stick together with our friends, even if we fight and don't agree sometimes. Demonstrate this by picking up the name paper with the electrified balloon.

**TABLE/QUIET
ACTIVITY****Friendship Puzzle**

Photocopy and enlarge the storybook illustrations onto pieces of card stock. Cut the images into puzzles with four pieces each. Have children break into small groups and explain that the picture has been divided into four pieces. Give each child in each group a piece of the same puzzle so that children have to work together to put it together.
