



ALL-OF-GOVERNMENT PRINT TECHNOLOGY AND ASSOCIATED SERVICES FOR EDUCATION

The All-of-Government (AoG) Print Technology and Associated Services (PTAS) contract covers print equipment and associated services.

This single contract includes hardware, software, sector-specific products (such as wide and large format printers and scanners), related consultancy and provider-enabled services, and maintenance and servicing.

By participating in the PTAS contract it means you don't need to go through a full procurement process on your own. This saves you a considerable amount of time, effort and cost.



How do you join AoG contracts?

To purchase from us, you first need to join the AoG contract with New Zealand Government Procurement. Visit www.procurement.govt.nz/contracts/joining-aog-contracts/ and follow the step-by-step process.

How PTAS works, and what you need to know

Statements of Work act as the contracting agreement between you and us. You can choose from a range of different pricing options:

- **Monthly Lease** pay a fixed monthly cost to lease print devices.
- Purchase outright purchase of print devices.
- **Standard Cost per Copy** pay a fixed per copy rate for selected print devices.
- Managed Cost per Copy pay a negotiated per copy rate for print devices selected by your provider.
- **Short Term Rental** to provide print devices for three months or less.

All pricing options have capped Service and Maintenance rates, which are charged per copy, and include the maintenance of devices and the provision of all consumables.
