| Queensland | Stated HERE by QLD Government Health, only registered health practitioners are permitted to practice. ANTA is in communication with QLD Government, requesting the ruling to change, so as to be consistent with the other states. | Not Permitted | |

| ACT | Stated HERE by the Chief Health Officer for the ACT Government. | Permitted | |
| Victoria | Stated HERE by the Department of Health and Human Services. Myotherapy was further clarified HERE . | Permitted | |
| Tasmania | As of the 20 th April, the Office of the state health commander has provided correspondence confirming that Myotherapists are permitted to practice from a medical or health facility. For Myotherapists who practice in a facility that may NOT be considered a health facility or medical facility, you can apply for an exemption via THIS FORM . We are seeking further clarification that this ruling can also be applied to Remedial Massage Therapists, but this has not been provided as yet. | Remedial Massage Uncertain | Myotherapy Permitted |
| South Australia | Stated HERE on Government of SA website, that “massage parlours” are to be closed. We are seeking more clarity and to determine if Remedial Massage / Myotherapy is exempt as it is in other states. | Uncertain | |
