Queensland	Stated HERE by QLD Government Health, only registered health practitioners are permitted to practice. ANTA is in communication with QLD Government, requesting the ruling to change, so as to be consistent with the other states.	Not Permitted
New South Wales	Stated HERE by the NSW Government on their COVID-19 web page.	Permitted
ACT	Stated HERE by the Chief Health Officer for the ACT Government.	Permitted
Victoria	Stated HERE by the Department of Health and Human Services. Myotherapy was further clarified HERE .	Permitted
Tasmania	Stated HERE by the Director of Public Health Tasmania, that only registered health practitioners are permitted to practice. We are seeking more clarity and to determine if Remedial Massage / Myotherapy is exempt as it is in other states. There has been communication from Tas government to suggest that there may be further updates coming.	No Permitted
South Australia	Stated HERE on Government of SA website, that "massage parlours" are to be closed. We are seeking more clarity and to determine if Remedial Massage / Myotherapy is exempt as it is in other states.	Uncertain
