Slow and steady wins the race

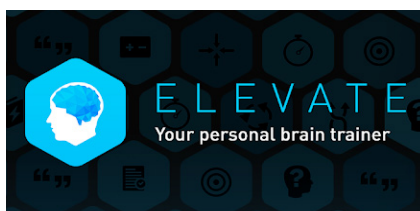

Each lesson lasts 20-30 minutes and the team recommends you do one session a day.

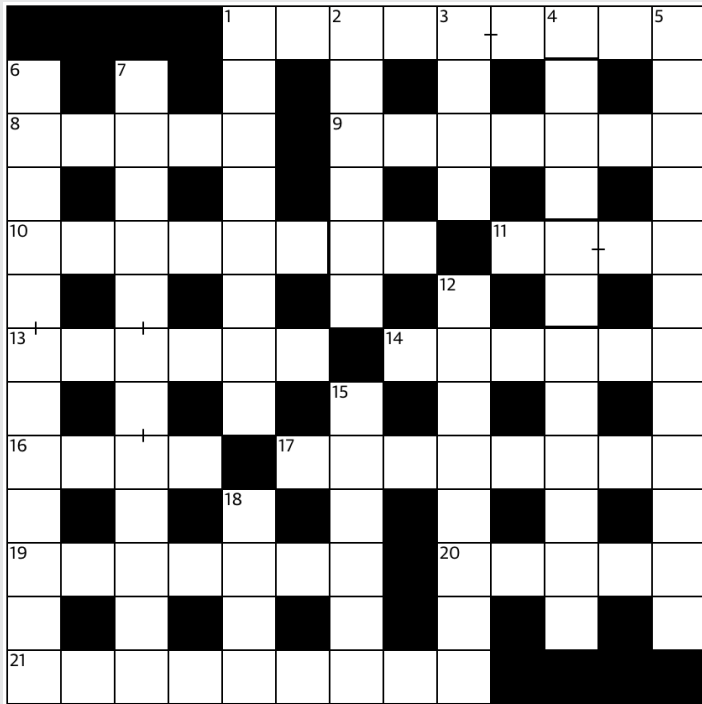

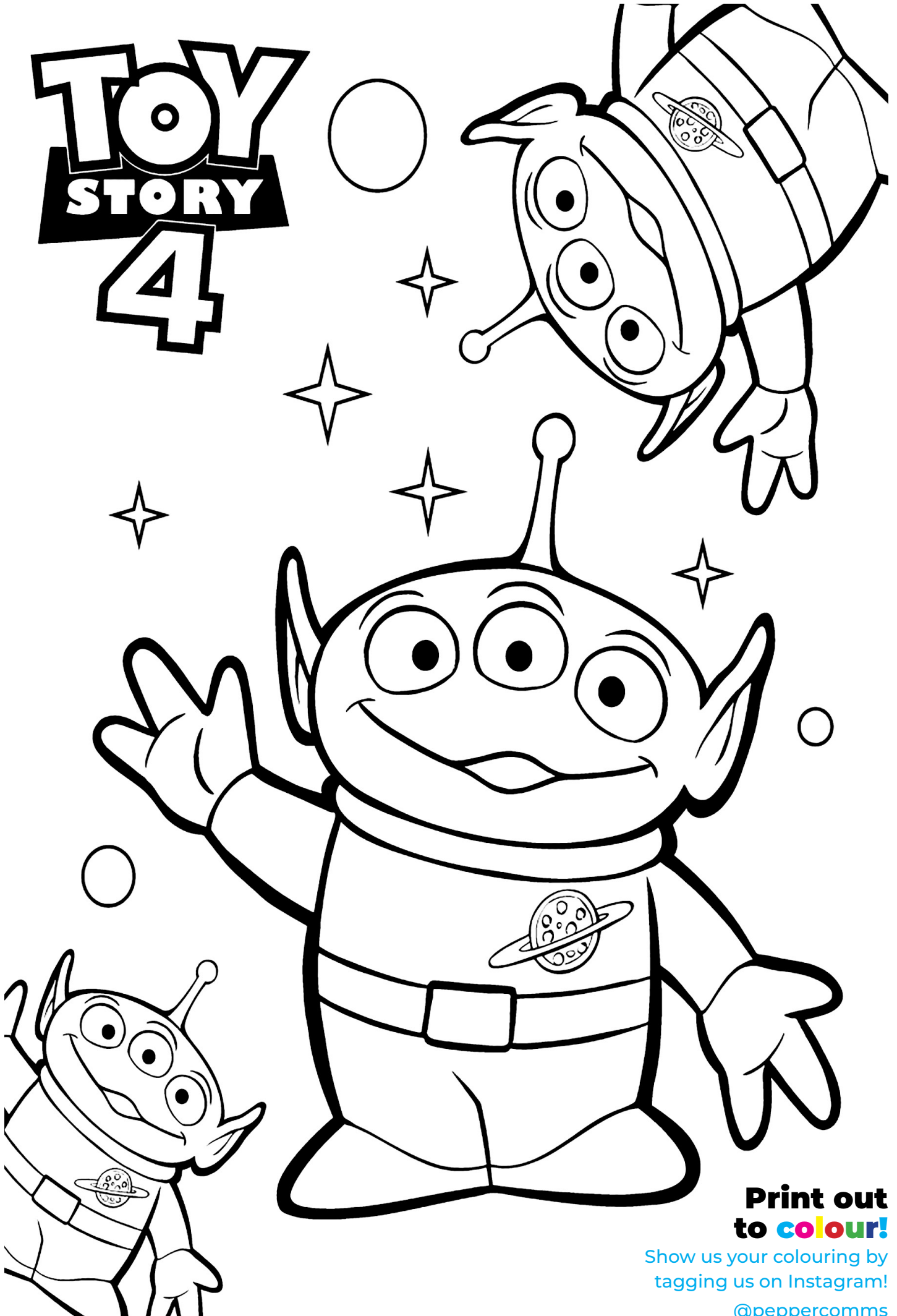
