They have your medical records and may have a provider on call who can help. Before any urgent care situation happens, it's important to understand your choices.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, it's a good idea to call ahead or check online to understand the safety protocols retail health clinics and urgent care centers have in place to keep patients safe.
