



The Surrogacy Plan at RMA of Connecticut

A simpler approach to treatment that helps you control costs with the best chance for success.

The Surrogacy Plan is designed to help patients who choose to use a surrogate have more control over the cost of treatment.

The Surrogacy Plan at RMA of Connecticut (RMACT) is available to individuals and couples who want to build a family using a surrogate (sometimes referred to as a gestational carrier). In this process, eggs from either the female patient or an egg donor are retrieved and combined with sperm to create embryos. One or two embryos are then transferred into the uterus of the surrogate to achieve a pregnancy. The availability of multiple embryos can make it possible to complete more than one transfer cycle if necessary.

How the Surrogacy Plan at RMACT Works

The Surrogacy Plan at RMACT is designed to help control the cost of treatment for individuals and couples using a surrogate. The Surrogacy Plan covers cycle medication for the donor and gestational carrier, two days of in cycle monitoring for the donor and one day of in cycle monitoring for the gestational carrier (at one for RMACT's four locations), anesthesia for the retrieval of oocytes, egg retrieval, embryology laboratory charges, embryo transfer into the gestational carrier, cryopreservation of embryos, and the first year of storage. In the event the embryo transfer is unsuccessful and does not result in a live birth, The Surrogacy Plan covers the cost of an additional frozen embryo transfer if a frozen embryo is available.

The cost of The Surrogacy Plan at RMACT is **\$24,000.00**.

What is NOT included in RMACT's Surrogacy Plan

- Costs associated with compensation or legal fees for the gestational carrier or egg donor
- Cycle monitoring or screening for the egg donor or gestational carrier (other than what is specified above)
- Psychological evaluations
- Medical treatment associated with an unsuccessful cycle (treatment for miscarriage, ectopic or biochemical pregnancy)
- Oocyte cryopreservation
- TESA/MESA if required
- Testing for the intended parent(s)
- Preimplantation Genetic Screening (PGS) or Preimplantation Genetic Diagnosis (PGD)
- Pregnancy related treatment and pregnancy medications
- Storage of embryos and sperm starting the second year
