Introduction

When you're faced with infertility and wish to seek fertility treatment, the first thing you will need to decide is which fertility doctor to see and at what practice. Oftentimes, this decision can seem overwhelming. Who will give you the best chance at the family you know you're meant to have?

There are many other questions that you will bring to your first office visit: How much does IVF treatment cost? What kind of fertility training does my doctor have? How much time will I spend in a clinic office being tested and getting treatment? How do I get started?

Modern fertility treatments rely significantly on science to determine a cause of infertility and the best way to treat it. That makes the fertility doctors at any practice very important. You want them to have in-depth diagnostic experience, a thirst for new knowledge, and unwavering compassion.

A successful, enjoyable, confident experience will be dependent on your doctor's ability, clinic and lab accreditation, and the other services a practice offers, like convenience, emotional support, and other patient-focused amenities.

Do the fertility doctors meet the **highest standards**?



All of our six fertility doctors are board-certified in **Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility** (REI), the gold standard for fertility doctors. Beyond medical residency and examination in obstetrics and gynecology, our doctors were extensively trained and tested for another three years of advanced training in REI. Additionally, our fertility doctors continuously update their knowledge with published research and collaboration with other physicians. Which insurance carriers does the **fertility clinic participate** with?





From your first call to RMA of Connecticut, we can provide information about how your insurance company covers infertility treatment. Some insurance companies require that fertility patients seek treatment only from a practice designated as a Center of Excellence by In Vitro Sciences, an organization that sets the bar for fertility management and services.

RMA of Connecticut is one of just 16 such centers in the country. The Center of Excellence distinction indicates that our practice meets the highest national standards for clinical fertility and laboratory services. Our selection into this exclusive group is based on key measures of success that evaluate a center's experience level, its overall live birth rate, and its low triplets-or-higher birth rate.

We are proud of our many recognitions and alliances, including being a Center of Excellence.

Additionally, RMA of Connecticut earned a perfect score from The Human Rights Campaign Foundation and a listing in the Healthcare Equality Index for the third year in a row. Our practice is one of only two fertility practices in the nation recognized as "Leaders in Equality."



In addition to our membership in SART, we also work closely with the American Society for Reproductive Medicine, an educational and advocacy organization dedicated to the advancement of the science and practice of reproductive medicine.

And while fertility clinics are not required to seek accreditation, RMA of Connecticut's IVF laboratory is accredited by the College of American Pathologists and meets standards established by the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Act. Our practice is accredited by the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care, and the surgical suite is licensed by the State of Connecticut.
