Recently, several alumni and friends of Lehman Catholic have initiated a process that exemplifies the unselfish spirit characteristic of the Lehman community. These scholarships are new ways the Lehman community is redefining the affordability of tuition while encouraging a continual belief that it is this generation’s responsibility to provide opportunities for today’s students, opportunities that past supporters of Lehman Catholic provided for the students of their era.

The scholarships listed below may be applied for by using the Common Scholarship Application. All applications must be submitted by April 1. Applicants will be notified of the committee’s decision by May 15.

The Clifton Alexander Memorial Scholarship

The Clifton Alexander Memorial Scholarship was established in the memory of Clifton Alexander by his father, John Alexander. Clifton was a 2005 graduate of Lehman Catholic High School. Four \$1000 scholarships are awarded to incoming freshmen from Piqua Catholic School, St. Boniface or St. Mary parishes of Piqua, Ohio. These scholarships are renewable for an additional three years as long as the recipient(s) are in good standing at LCHS. For renewal and first time application, students must complete the common scholarship application.

The Carol Wesbecher Covault '56 Scholarship

The Carol Wesbecher Covault '56 Scholarship is designed to perpetuate the memories of Ms. Carol Wesbecher Covault. She was a 1956 graduate of Holy Angels High School. This scholarship was created by her loving sons. This is a one \$1,000 high school scholarship. The criteria is based on student service and financial need. **Applicants must complete the online financial aid application and the Lehman Catholic High School Scholarship Common Application.** This is a non-renewable scholarship. One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded.

The Dilworth Family Scholarship

Julia Dilworth left a legacy of giving through the endowment of The Dilworth Family Scholarship Fund. This scholarship is to benefit an incoming or current Lehman Catholic High School student(s). The scholarship is to embrace the legacy of Julia “Judy” Dilworth to the Catholic faith and Catholic education. The scholarship will reward students(s) who exhibit leadership and a giving heart, with a financial need for tuition assistance. This is a non-renewable scholarship and will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal and committee review. The scholarship will be awarded based upon financial need, character, scholarship and leadership qualities. Applicants must use the Lehman Catholic High School Common Scholarship Application and denote the selection of The Dilworth Family Scholarship Fund. Five \$1000 scholarships will be awarded.

The Richard & Harriet Frantz Scholarship

In the honor of their parents, the Frantz family has established the Richard and Harriet Frantz Scholarship Fund. Catholic education has always been a cornerstone of their family’s values. The family appreciates the sacrifices and the blessings that their parents provided by sending them to a Catholic school. In addition, to being the parents of thirteen Lehman Catholic and Holy Angels graduates, Richard Frantz was one of the original signers of the documents that created Lehman Catholic High School. Harriet worked to establish swimming and diving as a varsity sport at Lehman Catholic and coached the team for many years.

The Richard & Harriet Frantz Scholarship continued ...

The scholarship will be awarded based upon academic participation and good standing, citizenship, character, and need. The school's administrative team will make the selection of the recipient(s). In the event candidates are, in the view of the panel, evenly matched for the scholarship, then participation in scouting, participation in their Catholic Church, positive effort in the classroom, and community service can be used as deciding factors.

All students who are incoming freshmen through seniors are encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to financial need and incoming freshmen or students entering their first year at Lehman Catholic High School. Awarded scholarship(s) will range from \$500 to \$1000.

The Charles and Jane Gariety Scholarship

The Charles and Jane Gariety Scholarship provides one \$1000 scholarship awarded to an incoming freshmen or upperclassmen. Recipient(s) must be in good standing with the school. All students are encouraged to apply using the Lehman Catholic High School Common Application. The school's administrative team will make the selection of the recipients. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded.

The Celestine Gigandet High School Scholarship

Established to continue Catholic education for generations is the Gigandet High School Scholarship. This scholarship provides multiple scholarship annual awards. For the school year 2019 -20, approximately \$6,500 will be awarded to Lehman Catholic High School students. Individual scholarships, ranging from \$500 to \$1000, will be awarded.

The Frank A. Gilardi & Julie L. (Raterman) Gilardi Scholarship(s)

The Frank A. Gilardi & Julie L. (Raterman) Gilardi Scholarship(s) are funded through an endowment that will perpetually provide scholarships for Lehman Catholic students. Frank and Julie both have a desire to encourage the culture of giving that exists at Lehman Catholic. They saw an opportunity to encourage others through their own generosity by giving back to the school that has given their family so much. Holy Angel's parishioners, Frank and Julie are 1976 graduates of Lehman and are making available funds for up to five scholarships in the amounts of \$1000 - \$2500. These scholarships will be awarded to students attending Lehman Catholic High School. Priority will be given to incoming freshmen and students new to Lehman. The scholarship will be awarded based upon financial need. The school's administrative team will make the selection of the recipients. Up to five \$1000 scholarships will be awarded.

The James and Jean Hartzell Family Scholarship

In an effort to show his support to Lehman High School, James (Jim) Hartzell established the James and Jean Hartzell Scholarship to be applied toward tuition at Lehman Catholic High School. Jim was a former president of the Lehman Foundation Board and has supported the Lehman community for a number of years. The Hartzell Family Scholarship has been established for students who will attend Lehman Catholic High School. It is the Hartzell family's intention to help families from the area to attend Lehman Catholic and to assist those who feel that the cost of a Lehman Catholic education may be unattainable for economic reasons. All students who are incoming freshmen through seniors are encouraged to apply. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded.

The Percy G Holloway Scholarship

In honor of Percy G Holloway, a lifelong member of St. Mary's Church and the Knights of Columbus in Piqua, a one-time \$1000 scholarship has been established, for incoming and current students of Lehman Catholic. The scholarship will be based upon academic effort, financial need, and student service. The student's demonstration of hard work and common sense is a plus in the selection process. The school's administrative team will make the selection. One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded.

The Tom and Marilyn Jordan Scholarship

In honor and memory of their father and mother, the Jordan family has established the Tom Jordan Scholarship. In addition to being the parent of several Piqua Catholic and Lehman graduates, Tom Jordan was also a loyal employee of Lehman Catholic High School for 10 years and received an Honorary Diploma from Lehman in 1992. A Catholic Education has always been a cornerstone of the Jordan family's values and Tom cherished his time spent at Lehman as their head custodian.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, a student must be an incoming freshman at Lehman, who is currently attending Piqua Catholic School. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded.

Learn, Live, Love, LEHMAN Scholarship

The Learn, Live, Love LEHMAN Scholarship has been established to encourage students to choose Catholic education at Lehman Catholic High School. All students (incoming freshman through senior) are eligible to apply, particularly students who reside in Miami County. Individual scholarships, ranging from \$200 to \$1500, will be awarded.

The Patrick Michael Pudlewski Scholarship

The Pudlewski Scholarship was established in loving memory of Patrick Michael Pudlewski. The scholarship is based on involvement with the school community through co-curricular and/or extra-curricular activities. Candidates will have demonstrated the ability to make positive contributions to the school and the greater community. This \$1000 scholarship is only available to upperclassmen attending Lehman Catholic High School.

The Scott Family Scholarship

Benny (Lehman graduate '89) and Stacy Scott share a passion for Catholic Education and have been supporters of Piqua Catholic and Lehman Catholic High School for years. To assure that a Catholic Education is an option for families in their community, they have established the Scott Family Scholarship, which will be awarded to one or two students from Piqua and/or of Miami County. The scholarship will be awarded primarily based on the student's character and financial need. It is targeted towards families with financial need that may choose otherwise not to send students to Lehman without this additional help. Students should have a hard work ethic and be active in extracurricular and service activities. They should also be in good academic standing. All students who are incoming freshmen through seniors are encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to financial need and incoming freshmen or students entering their first year at Lehman Catholic High School. The recipient can and will be encouraged to reapply annually while attending Lehman High School. A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of Benny and Stacy Scott with the advisement of the school's Principal.

The Norm & Jean Smith Family Scholarship

All of the Smith children, Tracy, Todd, Matt, Mindy, Molly and Abbi graduated from Lehman Catholic High School and completed college using the skills and knowledge acquired from Lehman. All the children participated in multiple extracurricular activities offered by the school, including music, sports, leadership, service and academic clubs. The family has always been supportive of Catholic education and wish to continue their support by helping future students. Two individual scholarships of \$1000, with a possibility of renewal will be awarded to a Shelby county resident and based on financial need.

The Dennis and Rita Sollmann Family Scholarship

This scholarship was established to honor Dennis and Rita Sollmann by their children for all they have done for Holy Angels and Lehman Catholic High Schools over the past 35 years. They are strong supporters of Catholic education and want to reward a deserving student and their family for their hard work and success while attending Holy Angels School. The scholarship will be awarded to an 8th-grade student at Holy Angels that will be attending Lehman Catholic High School in the fall. The scholarship will be based on the student's church activities, extracurricular activities, community involvement and need. The student must be in good standing with Holy Angels School. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded by June 15 and will be applied to the next school year's tuition.

The Ann Vondenhuevel Scholarship

In honor and memory of his wife and their mother, the Vondenhuevel family has established the Ann Vondenhuevel Scholarship. Ann (Frantz) Vondenhuevel was a graduate from Lehman in 1981 and lost her battle with cancer in 2011. Catholic education has always been a cornerstone of the Vondenhuevel family and the Ann Vondenhuevel Scholarship was established to help other families have this opportunity for a Lehman Catholic Education. All students who are incoming freshmen through seniors are encouraged to apply. The scholarship will be awarded to someone who really desires to attend Lehman and is based upon merit, character, and need. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded.

The Art and Sarah Zimpfer Scholarship

In honor of Art and Sara Zimpfer, a one-time \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a St. Patrick's graduate who is attending Lehman Catholic. This scholarship will be awarded based on financial need and character. The determination of the recipient will be made by the Administrative team at St. Patrick's school.
