



HOW IT WORKS


Step 1: Vector Solutions sends the course data to your LMS Administrator




Step 2: Your LMS Administrator imports and assigns the courses within your LMS



Step 3: The Student launches the training within your LMS, which then sends a request to Vector Solutions's Server to play the course



Step 4: Once the Student exits the course, the course sends specific data to your LMS (i.e. lesson status, score, time, etc.)



Frequently Asked Questions



How does the technical set up begin?

A member from our Support team will reach out to your LMS Administrator and provide one of two files: (1) a file with the detailed course data; and/or (2) zip files for each of the courses you purchased.

What exactly is in the “course data” Vector Solutions sends to the LMS Administrator?

This file is either a Microsoft Excel or CSV file (your choice) which outlines the following information:

- Course ID
- Title
- Course Length (in hours)
- Passing Score
- Course Description
- Course Objectives
- Course Language
- Launch URL

What should we expect after the initial set up?

We'll help your LMS Administrator stay in the loop with monthly notifications detailing new course releases as well as informing your LMS Administrator of when obsolete courses will be discontinued and what their replacements will be.

How are course updates handled?

As regulations change, so do our courses. Your courses will automatically update as soon as we're able to make the change.

Are there any customization options to your courses?

Yes, your LMS Administrator can customize the global settings for course functionality in a few ways:

- Enable or disable printing of the exam material
- Enable or disable reviewing exam results
- Enable or disable students to complete the exam in one sitting
- Override the default passing score from 70% to another percentage
- And more...

Are there any technical specifications we should be aware of?

Yes, your LMS will need to be either AICC- or SCORM-compliant. For an AICC-compliant LMS, we follow CMI Guidelines for Interoperability (CMI001) Revision 4.0 release 16-Aug-2004. We are also backward compatible with AICC 2.2 Level 1. For a SCORM-compliant LMS, we follow SCORM 1.2 specifications.
