EEE virus is a rare cause of brain infections (encephalitis). Approximately 30% of people with EEE die and many survivors have ongoing neurologic problems.²



However, it reports that approximately 1,500 cases of malaria are documented each year in the United States due to imported cases, mainly from travelers.³
