

PAYROLL TAX RELIEF PACKAGE

As part of the announcement made on 16 March 2020, the Government of Western Australia has announced a payroll tax relief package to support WA small to medium businesses in the wake of the COVID-19 crisis.

With an aim to provide temporary cashflow assistance to small and medium businesses that employ staff, this measure will provide for:

- the \$1 million payroll tax threshold to be brought forward by six months to 1 July 2020.
- a one-off grant of \$17,500 to businesses whose annual Australian taxable wages are more than \$1 million and up to \$4 million.
- Deferral of 2019-20 payroll tax payment until 21 July 2020 for small and medium businesses (employers who pay \$7.5 million or less in Australian Taxable Wages) and have been directly or indirectly impacted by COVID-19, compared to normal operating conditions.

How to claim the grant

- There is no need to apply for the grant.
- All grants will automatically be paid to eligible businesses by way of a cheque from July 2020.
- There may be delays in receiving payment for taxpayers whose tax status changed in 2018-19 or who became liable for payroll tax during the 2018-19 or 2019-20 assessment year.
- All eligible businesses must ensure its postal address is correct with the Office of State Revenue.

Deferral of payment of returns and how to apply

To apply for the deferral of payroll tax payments, the Payroll tax Deferral Application Form must be completed and submitted online via a web enquiry on the Office of State Revenue website. (https://rol.osr.wa.gov.au)

- If the application is successful:
- payments will be deferred from the first return period after the date in which you are affected;
- returns are still to be lodged although no payment is being made; and
- for all deferred months, returns must be lodged, and liability paid by 21 July 2020.
