


Travelers Returning from Abroad and Sister Islands Travel

Travelers returning from abroad **strongly urged not to travel to the Sister Islands**



There is heightened concern surrounding the importation of COVID-19 to Cayman Brac and Little Cayman given the high percentage of elderly persons residing there, limited resources and the additional challenges that the remoteness of the Islands poses for serious cases.

For these reasons, **all international travelers who planned to continue to the Sister Islands** are being given accommodations to self-isolate at a dedicated hotel in Grand Cayman.

- Arrangements have been made to accommodate inbound passengers on international flights who are transiting Grand Cayman for the Sister Islands.
- On medical advice, isolation accommodations have been made available to all persons arriving on flights from abroad who planned to continue to Cayman Brac and Little Cayman. This includes students and others.

We strongly urge persons not to continue through to the Sister Islands. We are therefore giving them the means to do the responsible thing and stay in place in Grand Cayman until the self-isolation period has expired or another provision can be made which can provide similar assurance.
