Given the prevalence of the Coronavirus around the world, all travellers arriving from overseas between **Thursday 19th March and Sunday 22nd March** have travelled from an affected area and are being asked to self-isolate (stay away from other people).

You have two options. Self-isolation at home or self-isolation at the facility arranged by the Cayman Islands Government. We hope you've had an opportunity to discuss these options with your family.
