

715 Health Check



What's a 715?

A 715 is an annual health check that assesses your physical and mental wellbeing. The '715' refers to the Medicare item number linked to the Health Check.

How much does it cost?

Your 715 is free.

How long does it take?

Allow 40-60 minutes for your health check.

What will happen in my 715?

Your 715 can vary depending on your age and needs. It covers your physical, mental and social health.

You will be asked about your lifestyle choices such as smoking status, alcohol and other drugs, nutrition and level of physical activity. You will be asked about family history and any medications you may be taking. You may also be asked to have a blood and wee test.

This is also your opportunity to have a yarn with us about anything that is of concern, or you would like more info about.

All your information remains confidential. The health workers cannot share any of your information without your consent.

How often should I have one?

You should have a 715 every 9-12 months. Think about it as your 'annual' health check.

Who will do my 715?


Your 715 will be done by an Aboriginal Health Worker and your Doctor.
