Software Releases under a particular Version

A “**Version**” is a series of Releases of a particular software product with a common “x.y” denomination in the first two places of the Release identifier. A “**Release**,” on the other hand, is a particular image issued under a particular Version. For example, CloudTV Platform V2.1 SR1 through CloudTV Platform V2.1 SR9 are all Releases under the same Version 2.1, whereas CloudTV Platform V2.1 SR1 and CloudTV Platform V2.2 SR1 are Releases under different Versions. Releases within a particular Version generally have common features and functionality.

From version 2.6 on, ActiveVideo has adopted a simpler versioning scheme



for CloudTV platform: the SR(Service Release) and HF (Hot Fix) annotations to the release versions will be replaced by simple dots. As such, the 2.6 feature release will be called 2.6.0, the first service release after 2.6 will be called 2.6.1 instead of 2.6 SR1, and a hotfix on 2.6 would be announced as 2.6.0.1.

Older maintenance releases will still use the old scheme, for example, next service release on 2.4 will be called 2.4 SR3.

EOL to a version means all the releases under that version will no longer be supported.

EOL statements for Products known as GuideCast and StreamCast is different from EOL of a Platform Version.
