Literacy

- 36 million adults possess low literacy skills (Source: <u>National Center for Education Statistics</u>)
- Over 8 million of these adults struggle to read even short texts to locate information (Source: <u>National Center for Education Statistics</u>)
- For those working in the service sector, which has been hardest hit by the COVID-19 pandemic:
 - 62% have low literacy
 - 74% have low numeracy

Lack of online access

- For adults who earn less than \$30,000 a year:
 - 44% of adults do not have home broadband services
 - 46% do not have a traditional computer
 - o 29% do not have smartphones
