He has served on the national faculty for the HRSA Workplace Partnership for Life (WPFL) campaign, and even developed the “Get Connected” webinar series for the program.

In his role as Director of Hospital Services, Hudson will provide leadership, support, and development opportunities for his team whose primary responsibilities include educating hospital staff on the sophisticated referral and donation process as well as building and nurturing positive relationships within each hospital served by NDN.
