Kinderdijk - A UNESCO World Heritage Site

I am a kind of solo traveller (with a few exceptions) & have been to The Netherlands a few times and every time I have experienced something extraordinary which I would like to share ©.

I was in The Netherlands last month & I decided to explore the country more than what I did during my first trip (where I only visited Hilversum & Amsterdam).

This time I went to see Kinderdijk, Rotterdam & Utrecht. Kinderdijk was the first place on this trip (officially I was in Hilversum) & the trip began on 10th of March 2018.

What is Kinderdijk?

Kinderdijk is a village in South Holland (Zuid-Holland) situated around 15 Kms from Rotterdam, which is famous for its 19 windmills that were built in 18th century (around 1740) to keep the area dry & drain the water. It is located at the junction of rivers Lek & Noord.

Kinderdijk is one of the most famous & well known Dutch tourist sites. The group of old windmills is probably one of its kind & one doesn't get to see it anywhere else in the world. This is a prime example of Dutch water management & explains how Holland manages to keep itself dry despite being below the sea-level.

What To See?

It was hard for me to take my eyes off from those 19 old windmills standing along a long stretch of water with greenery everywhere. The view of windmills' reflection in the water is breath-taking. I am so glad that I decided to visit this beautiful place. Kinderdijk takes you back to the history. It takes you to an entirely different world which is quite different from what you see every day.

There are no skyscrapers, no glass buildings & no rush. The place is really peaceful and alluring. You can hear the sound of air & water flow.

You will also see water birds swimming in the water and occasionally diving or coming out of it. You can further explore the place through Kinderdijk.


