2 Day trip Excursion to the Lake Como

3 Day trip Excursion to the Lake Maggiore



After meeting your guide in the center of Milan, hop on the comfortable coach for the easy ride to Lake Maggiore. Also referred to as Lake Verbano, this beautiful body of water, lined with rustic villages on its shores, is the second largest lake in Italy. Hop off the coach in the town of Stresa, a chic lakeside town that is a magnet for the fashionable set. Take some time to explore the town, strolling down its streets, popping into boutiques and ambling along the shore.

Marvel at the villas perched on the shore, the verdant gardens and the mountains in the distance. Cruise around Isola Madre toward Isola dei Pescatori, where you'll disembark. Enjoy some free time here to explore the island on your own. Walk along the shore of the island or sit down at a local eatery for a lovely fish lunch. Get back on the boat and head to one more of the Borromean Islands. This time it is Isola Bella, Beautiful Island, where you can visit the Borromean Palace and gardens or discover the many shops, boutiques and cafés housed in historic buildings. Finally, you will rejoin the boat and cruise back to Stresa for your return Milan.

4 Day trip excursion to FoxTown outlet (Switzerland)

5 Day trip excursion to Bergamo



Imagine a raised plateau, like one of the mesas of the American southwest or Uluru in central Australia. Usually you'll encounter a formation like this out in nature. But in northern Italy's town of Bergamo, there is a large plateau with a UNESCO World Heritage old town perched at the top, surrounded by modern Bergamo, Italy.

It is this division that makes Bergamo unique, split into the historical, raised Città Alta with its meandering pedestrian cobblestone walkways and the lower Città Bassa with a bustling, modern city.

The upper city has incredible charm and a quite lengthy history, with all of its attractions close to one another in easy walking distance, making it an ideal destination for a day trip.

6 Visit Pinacoteca Ambrosiana or Brera



Today the Pinacoteca Ambrosiana has 24 rooms that follow a chronological trajectory that begins with the collection of Cardinal Federico until the beginning of the 20th century.

In its interior we find more than 1,500 works in wood, canvas and copper. The collection includes 248 designs by several masters including Raffaello from whom the great board of the School of Athens, the largest cardboard existing from the Italian Renaissance, and Leonardo of whom the "Codex Atlanticus" is preserved with its 1750 technical and scientific drawings.

The collection of the Pinacoteca di Brera includes some of the greatest masterpieces of Italian and foreign art from the 13th to the 20th century. The works are displayed on the first floor of the building, where the Academy of Fine Arts is also located.

The building itself, which dates back to the late Baroque period, was built on the remains of a 14th century monastery of the Humiliati religious order. The Academy of Fine Arts has been housed there since the second part of the 18th century thanks to the intervention of Maria Theresa, Empress of Austria.

7 Day trip excursion to Cantalupo wine yard and lunch in a typical Italian Osteria



The hills in the area between Gattinara and Ghemme, thanks to exposure to the sun and morainic terrain, were right from Roman times a favorable territory to the development of the wine culture.

There are many villages that have given the name to local wines, with excellent quality like other more famous Italian wines.

The Wineries in these towns are located in very attractive locations that combine an interest for art and wine.
