LEARN ABOUT OUR TYPES OF AUCTIONS

Live Auctions

All auctions are live and simulcast. Bids are taken in real-time. On-site and simulcast bidding means the bidders can be present at the auction site or logged on to bid online.

Timed Auctions

Centurion hosts timed auctions where buyers can bid 24/7 on high valued medical equipment such as installed radiology, MRI, CT machines and so much more.

EASY AUCTION REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Registration deposits are fully refundable if no items are purchased
- Deposit fee: \$2,000 for online bidders and \$500 for on-site bidders
- Proxy bidding: contact us for the proxy bid form Buyers can register as soon as the registration link is available on online via the Centurion website
- New buyers only: a valid driver's license or passport is required for registration
- All major credit card types are accepted except Discover
- All cashier's checks and bank wires are to be made out to Centurion Service Group
- All sales are subject to tax unless buyer provides a valid resale or tax registration certificate

HELPFUL AUCTION TERMINOLOGY

"As-is, where-is"

The item is sold in its present condition, with no return privileges.

"Lot"

Item being auctioned.

Auctioneer can announce one lot number or multiple lot numbers.

"So much a piece times the money" or "option"

If there is more than one of the same type of item, the auctioneer is asking the winning bidder to choose how many items he/she wants multiplied by the winning bid amount.

"Pass"

If an item is up for auction and no one bids or the bidding does not start at a number deemed acceptable by the auctioneer, the item will be passed. The auctioneer will then move onto the next item.

"Proxy bid"

Allows bidder to bid without being present at the auction on-site or online. Bidder submits the maximum price he/she would be willing to pay for an item and allows Centurion Service Group to bid on their behalf, up to the amount of the bid limit.
