# **Step 1: Frequently Asked Questions**

- 5 What lessons about teamwork can be learned from the rebuilding of the wall?
- 6 Ray said, "Together we can be something we cannot be individually." Do you like you are on the Seven Rivers team? Are you on the wall? Do you ever feel like the only one?

### BEAUTY RESTORED: THE SACRIFICE

- 7 What examples of sacrifice can you list from Nehemiah chapters 3 and 4?
- 8 What did Ray mean when he said, "It's not about equal gifts, it's about equal sacrifice"?
- 9 We serve and sacrifice not to *get* the favor of God, but because we *have* the favor of God. How did Nehemiah's decision to start the rebuilding of the wall at the Sheep Gate ultimately point forward to the Big Sacrifice of God?
