Businesses to Begin Selling on Yelp Yelp is allowing some businesses to make sales right from their personal Yelp profiles. Businesses will not need to opt into the new feature, nor will they need to pay for it. Yelp Platform, as it is called, will roll out category by category, starting with food pickup and delivery. Yelp will partner with third-party service providers, and existing customers will be brought into the platform, allowing ecommerce to happen seamlessly without clicking away to another site. Consumers will now be able to transact directly on the business listings they visit. Yelp will get a cut of revenue for transactions completed through its website, though percentages have not been disclosed.

Secret's Out: Now You Can Tell the Whole World You're Raising Money for Your Business The Securities and Exchange Commission voted to overturn the ban on publicly advertising that a private company is raising money ("general solicitation"). The lifting of the ban is one measure included in the Jumpstart Our Business Startups Act, or JOBS Act, that was signed into law in April last year. A founder of a company can now indicate on their Facebook page, Twitter feed and any other personal networks that their company is raising money. It is expected that the new law will be implemented in mid-September.

Google to Discontinue Adwords Tool for Websites Google will discontinue the Adwords External Keyword Research Tool, and launch Keyword Planner. The Adwords tool has commonly been used in determining which specific keywords a webmaster should target for search engine optimization (SEO) and pay-perclick campaigns (PPC). The major difference between the old and new tools will be in structure with the purpose of Keyword Planner being to help advertisers create new PPC ad groups and ad campaigns as quickly as possible. The shutdown date hasn't been confirmed, though it's expected to occur soon.

Create Easy Web Integrations with Zapier

Almost all online businesses are actively using at least a few web management tools to help keep things running smoothly. There aren't too many "all-in-one" services that do anything that a micro-biz would need. Most of us use email of course, maybe Evernote, perhaps Basecamp, FreshBooks and Mailchimp too—but they are all separate services. But, what if there was a way to automatically move information from one to another?

Enter Zapier. Zapier is similar to IFTTT in concept in that the user and create their own "recipes" – but Zapier focuses on user-created connections between web services ("Zaps") rather than linking actions based on specific types of information. Zapier will create connections between AWeber and Highrise, Twitter and Infusionsoft, or GoToWebinar and Google Contacts... it's up to you. "Zaps" are very customizable, with conditional filters and other options available, depending on the services being linked.

Zapier offers connections for up to 134 services, but many higher-end apps (such as Basecamp Next and Infusionsoft) are only included in a premium subscription, which begins at a very reasonable \$15/month. If you just want to try it out, a very robust free option should do fine. - *Contributed by Mary Motz; ProVirtualSolutions.* com

Changes in US Patent Law

This past March, patent law made an important shift that all entreps should be aware of. The new system is known as "first-to-file" which means patents go to the first entity to file an application. In the past, if you could prove that you were the first to invent the product, you were awarded a patent. Additionally, patents will be judged against international inventions, not just those created in the US.

With these new rules: 1- Be sure to search the World Intellectual Property Organization's Patentscope and the European Patent Office's website. 2- Consider filing a "provisional application" which will hold your patent for one year-- only \$130 for provisional filing! The good news- the US Patent and Trademark Office is setting up pro-bono patent assistance centers across the country! Learn more: www.uspto.gov/inventors/proseprobono

How to Send Pre-Scheduled Emails

Ever wish you could find a tool to help you write an email now but send it later, without it sitting as a draft? It's possible and we'll show you how! With helpful tools such as **Boomerang, RightInbox, and Outlook's scheduling options** you can write up your email now and have it sent at the exact date and time you choose! You're in control!

For example, you can use this functionality to send reminders to yourself to pay bills, schedule birthday/holiday notes, send confirmation emails, make sure you're following up on leads and sales, or communicate more effectively with different time zones. Below is an overview of some of our favorite tools to easily automate your life and send email on your own terms- even when you're sleeping!

Boomerang for Gmail is a Firefox/Chrome plugin that lets you take control of when you send and receive email messages. You get to choose the schedule, set follow ups as well as reminders if you don't hear back. This awesome tool is now available for Mobile as well!

RightInbox integrates seamlessly with Gmail and lets you once again—be in control. RightInbox allows you to send emails scheduled for any date, any time along with reminders. But get this, RightInbox has the awesome feature of tracking when your email is read as well as if the recipient opens it and clicks on any attachments or embedded links. How cool is that?! (Not that you have time to stalk!) You no longer need to worry if your email was successfully sent.

How can we forget our ever so outstanding **Outlook**? It too allows us to control our scheduling. Compose a new email and look to your toolbar for a tab labeled "Options." Within this tab you are able to request a delivery receipt, request a read receipt, delay delivery and send direct replies to a specific person. By clicking on delay delivery, you can choose 'Do not deliver before...' and choose your desired date/time.

Extra Credit: Try Yesware for Gmail if you really want to trick out your email automation and track prospects! This free add-on for Chrome and Firefox for Gmail allows you to see who opens your email and clicks on your links and provides customized analytics including google maps integration! You can use it to set reminders to keep track of prospects, set it to sync seamlessly with CRMs like Salesforce and Zoho and create customized templates to quickly handle correspondence-- and these templates can even be shared with your team!
