## FASTVET

**FAST** is an acronym for the abbreviated ultrasound examination called *Focused Assessment with Sonography for Trauma* created as a triage and post-interventional screening test by human trauma surgeons in the 1990s.

Abdominal FAST (AFAST<sup>SM</sup>), thoracic FAST (TFAST<sup>SM</sup>), Vet BLUE<sup>SM</sup>, and Global FAST<sup>SM</sup> (GFAST) have been developed by **FASTVet™** for veterinarians as rapid, point-of-care screening tests, that within minutes answer important clinical questions to help better direct both care and diagnostics in small animals.

These 3 techniques require no shaving of dogs and cats, minimal restraint, and serve as screening tests for Trauma, Triage and Tracking (monitoring)—thus the T3 designation.

These are truly practice-changers! You will quickly become a believer using these 3 techniques as extensions of your physical exam on a daily basis (the T3); and by capturing diseases, conditions and injuries with the use of AFAST<sup>SM</sup>, TFAST<sup>SM</sup>, Vet BLUE, and Global FAST<sup>SM</sup> (GFAST) that you would have traditionally missed or been delayed in dogs and cats of your valuable clients.
