RULES OF ENGAGEMENT

INTRODUCTION

This document constitutes the rules of engagement (ROE) for the Maryland Innovation and Security Institute (MISI) Hack The Building Event. You the possessor must agree to the terms and conditions set forth in this document to be considered a legal and authorized remote participant in this event. You must maintain a copy of this document during the entire event or your actions may be considered in violation of state and federal laws regarding offensive computer actions. Violation of any of the terms set forth in this document can constitute grounds for dismissal from this event without warning. In no event, shall MISI or its sponsors, be liable for any special, incidental, punitive, indirect or consequential damages (including lost profits or revenue) whatsoever arising out of or in any way related to this event.

You must not target or take any action against any asset not on this list. All participants agree to abide by the event whitelist and will not target any asset designated within the whitelist. An updated whitelist will be issued at the start of the event. All participants agree not to target any other participant, guest or viewer.

COMMUNICATION
