

ABL-LT Action Based Learning Lab Trainer

ABL recommends that each school utilizing an ABL lab, designates 1 ABL lab facilitator. This should be an individual that has shown strong interest and affinity towards Action Based Learning implementation. The job of the Lab Facilitator is to provide structure to the ABL program in the areas of scheduling, set-up, room layout, student progressions, and on-going care of the labs. As part of lab training packages, ABL provides up to 2 full days of on-site training for your designated lab facilitators. While this training is specifically designed for individuals assigned to running the labs, teachers and administrators are welcome to attend. (Up to 20 persons maximum)

HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR:

Anyone currently [or planning on] utilizing an ABL Lab in any capacity.
[Starter Labs and/or complete labs]
Not required, but highly encouraged for successful ABL Lab Implementation

Action Based Learning School Trainer

Receiving an ABL School Trainer Certification means an individual is authorized to provide leadership, training, and support for ABL throughout your school. ABL recommends nominating (2+) individuals from each school to become ABL school trainers. ABL-ST provides participants with all necessary training, materials, and coursework to obtain certification. Becoming an ABL-ST requires hands-on experience implementing ABL strategies. School Trainers [ABL-ST] are eligible to begin the process of becoming an ABL District Trainer (ABL-DT).

ABL-ST Action Based Learning - School Trainer

REQUIREMENTS:

- [1x] Attendance at any ABL Specialty Workshop: 3L, ABL in PE, etc
- [1x] Completion of 1 of 4 available introductory specialty ABL courses
- [1x] Completion of "Intro to Train the Trainers" ABL Course Program
- [1x] Completion of ABL-101 Online Course: 12 Foundations of Learning Readiness

EXPERIENCE:

- [3 yrs] Proven classroom* experience
- [1 yr] Proven experience* having implemented or mentored a group of educators utilizing "ABL in the Classroom"
- [1 semester] Proven experience* working with students in an official ABL lab/ classroom and demonstrated the use of the lab manual & corresponding equipment effectively

**Proven Experience requires an individual to complete and submit ABL Report, signed by Administration.*

ABL Certified District Trainers work throughout their school district to teach and implement the science and benefits of Action Based Learning. Certification at this level entitles ABL-DT to ongoing access to existing ABL content as well as input in the development of new ABL initiatives. As an integral part of the recognized international community, ABL-DT will meet regularly to present and strategize with other district leaders on ABL best practices. Includes all access passes to the ABL Online Academy : ABL Neuroscience Course. Includes All Access Passes to the ABL Certified District Trainer Course. Includes Attendance at on-site TOT (trainer of trainers) offered as a pre-conference event by existing ABL master trainers.

REQUIREMENTS:

- [1x] Successful completion of ABL Online Academy: Brain Science Course
- [1x] Successful completion of ABL Online Academy: Certified District Trainer Course
- [1x] Proven Data collection of ABL implementation
- [1x] Attend an official ABL 3L workshop
- [1x] Attend (TOT) trainer of trainers offered as an ABL pre-conference event
- [1x] Assisted and presented @ ABL Workshop within the last 2 years
- [3 per yr] Provided ABL Presentations throughout district

EXPERIENCE:

- [1x] Developed a new ABL specialty area or added value to an existing specialty area.
(EX: 3L, ABL in Physical Education, Math, Science, ELA, etc.)
 - [5-10] activities or lessons implemented that support chosen ABL specialty.
 - [1+] Atleast 1 campus within district has successfully completed ABL school certification
- School trainers are required to have minimum of:
- [1 yr] as a certified ABL School Trainer (ABL-ST)
 - [1 yr] practicing a successful implementation of ABL in the classroom at multiple grade levels
